## Feedback Analysis Action Taken Report 2021-22


Feedback Analysis Action Taken Reports as minute by the Governing Council (GC) of the college meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup> June 2022.

- The total number of students registered in the college for the academic year 2021-2022 is 2435 (UG+PG). The college received a total of 467 replies from students in all three years, alumni, and faculty.
- The IQAC is continuously striving to set up virtual lectures and webinars to refine the abilities of the students in response to comments supplied by various stakeholders for the enhancement of the curriculum and other facilities. 

1	Student	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Difficulty in internal assessments was faced by students during pandemic</li><li>• 10% of students is agreed with the Statement that ICT tools are effectively used by the teachers</li><li>• Course content in the curriculum has to be revised from time to time and the course contents should have good balance between theory and practical. Further, care to be taken to prepare curriculum which intellectually stimulate all the students.</li><li>• Slow learners are not given enough assistance by remedial and coaching classes.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The Online mode of classes did not offer enough scope to conduct remedial and coaching classes to help slow learners. Instead, simple class notes, ppt slides and voice notes were shared with them.</li><li>• For online mode Teachers were not compatible. They were trained to use more alternative methods of teaching.</li><li>• A judicious mix of online quizzes, handwritten and online assignments, viva-voce and project work was used to assess the level of understanding of students.</li><li>• Timely dissemination of information regarding internal assessment and evaluation was ensured.</li><li>• Faculty repeatedly reached out to the students who were falling.</li><li>• Teachers also ensured to reach out to the students and helped them to deal with the stress.</li><li>• Mentor-mentee platform was strengthened.</li><li>• Active monitoring of student attendance by faculty for timely identification and support.</li></ul>








