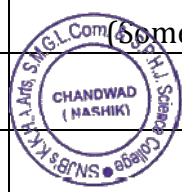


Feedback Analysis Report Academic Year 2021-22

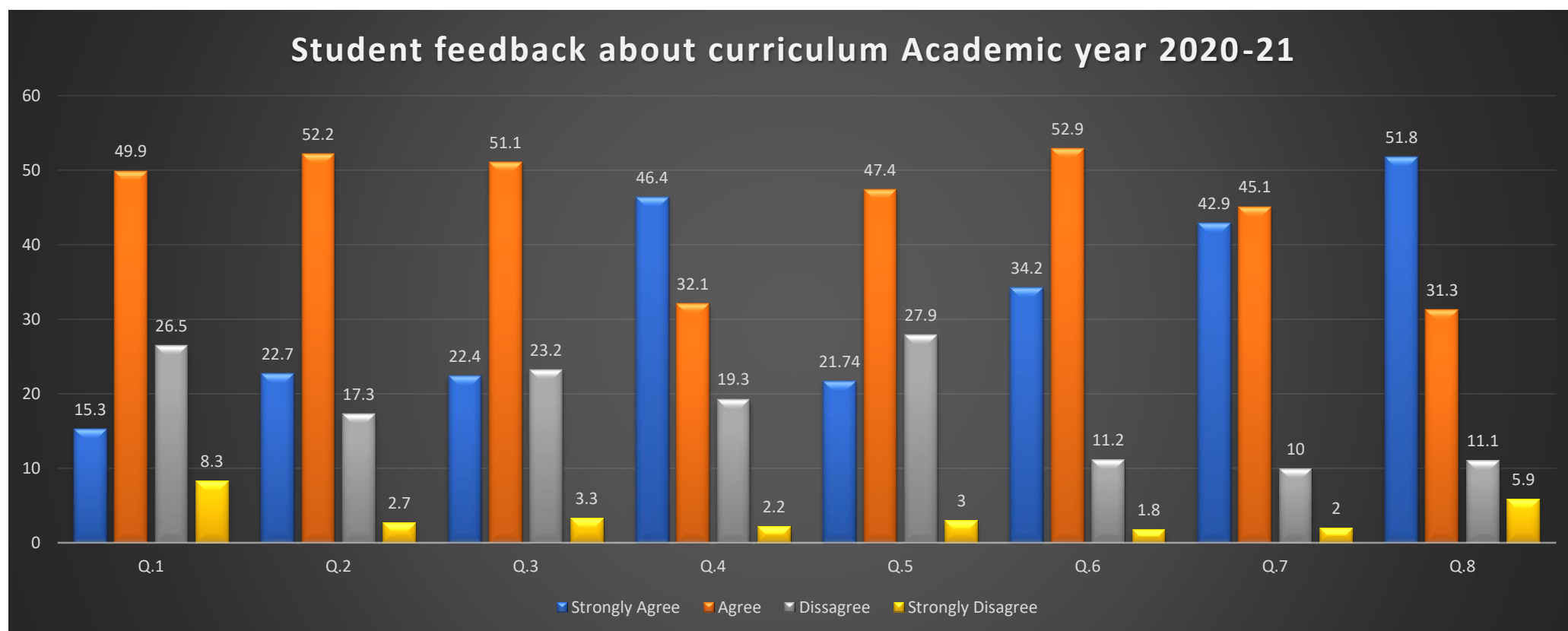

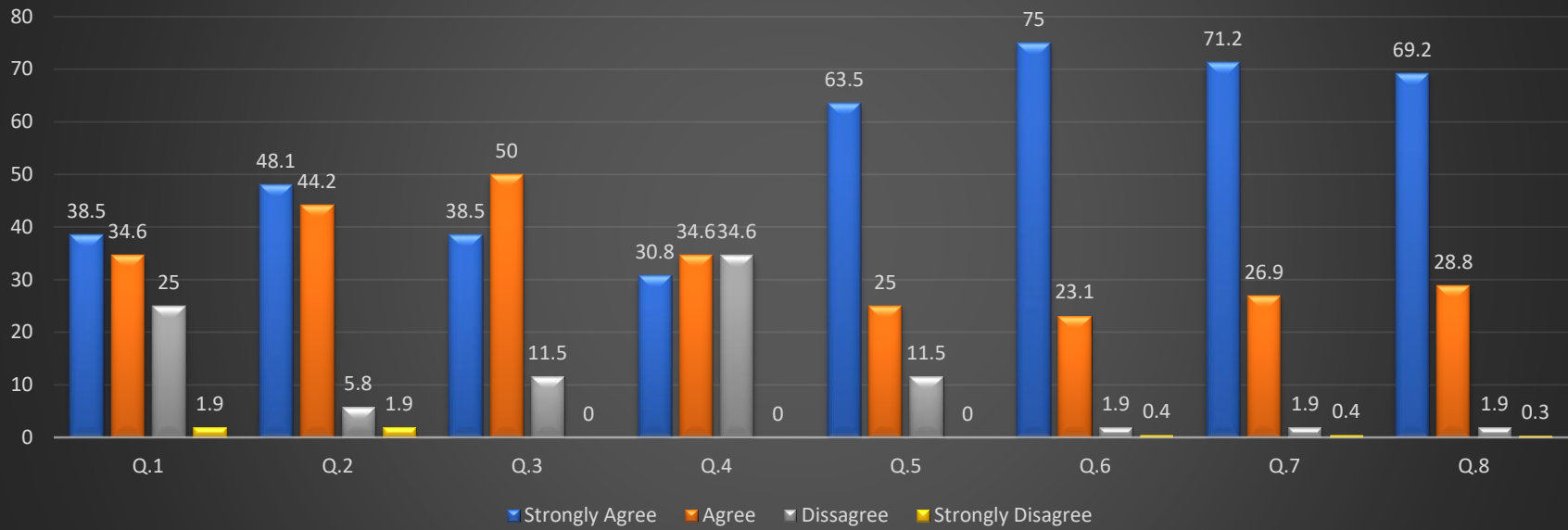
